

Our Practitioners work with children, birth to 17 years old, to support **Placement Prevention** for children at who are at risk of out-of-home placement through DSS.

DSS Social workers can make referrals to this program, if the following criteria are met:

- The parent(s)/caregiver(s) are aware of the referral for Homebuilders®, and at least one parent/caregiver in the home is willing to participate.
- Confirm the family will be available for an intake session within 24 hours of referral.

 Confirm the family will be available to meet with a Practitioner 3 to 5 times per week, for a total of approximately 40 hours, during a 4 to 6 week period.

- Maintaining the child in the home is not just a temporary plan.
 The child is not on a waiting list or pending entry into out-of-home treatment, alternative placementor a juvenile justice institution.
- The parent(s)/caregiver(s) have been informed of the risk of removal or re-removal.
- DSS Referring Worker has had contact with the family within 2 business days prior to referral for placement prevention.

Our team is available 24/7 to support children and families in times of need.
